Lessons are invoiced termly, to be paid in advance of the ballet term. A discount of 10% is offered for all siblings attending classes or for those attending more than one class per week.

About our school:

In 1976, after gaining her Registered Teacher Status with the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD RTS), Mrs. Jill Chase founded Lyme School of Ballet. Having danced and sung professionally, Mrs. Chase has a lifetime of dance, ballet and artistic experience alongside a wealth of teaching experience and knowledge.

Miss Freya Lovett, a student of Mrs Chase's since the age of 12, is now the school's Principal and sole teacher. Miss Freya holds a Level 4 Certificate and Level 5 Diploma in Dance Education. She recently gained her own Registered Teacher Status with the RAD. Miss Freya is an experienced dancer having completed all RAD examinations from Pre-Primary to Grade 8 (Distinction) and Intermediate Foundation, Intermediate and Advanced 1 of their pointe work Vocational Syllabi.

The school follows the RAD Ballet syllabi and examination system for girls and boys, teaching dancers aged 2.5 years and older. We also have a growing community of adult dancers and offer lessons under the RAD's new Silver Swans® programme. Miss Freya is a licensed Silver Swans teacher and classes advocate the role that ballet plays in all generations' health and wellbeing.

Students are welcomed to all-inclusive and friendly classes which are held mainly at The Woodmead Halls in Lyme Regis (DT7 3PG). However, some classes may be run from Lyme Regis' Parish Church Hall (DT7 3DB), the Uplyme Scout Hut (DT7 3TX) or Rousdon's Peek Hall (DT7 3XW). Advanced notice of venue changes will be provided in good time.

There is the opportunity for students to participate in our annual Summer School, designed to stretch and challenge our dancers with free classical, non-syllabus work. Every other year, following our Summer School, students are invited to take part in the Lyme Regis Carnival Procession in a '*corps de ballet*' dancing down Lyme Regis high street.

In the New Year, the school often supports the local Pantomime Society, performing in their annual show. This is the perfect opportunity for our students to find their feet in performance, if they so wish.

You may wish to dance as a hobby, for exercise or more professionally in the future; whatever your reasons, all ages and abilities are catered for at Lyme School of Ballet.
