Lessons are invoiced termly, to be paid in advance. We have 3 terms per academic year and approximately 12 lessons in each term. A discount of 10% is offered for all siblings attending classes or for students who attend more than one class per week.

## About Lyme School of Ballet:

In 1976, after gaining her Royal Academy of Dance Registered Teacher Status (RAD RTS), Mrs. Jill Chase founded Lyme School of Ballet (LSB). Having danced and sung professionally, Mrs. Chase has a lifetime of dance, ballet and artistic experience alongside a wealth of teaching experience and knowledge. In 2018, Mrs. Chase retired and Miss Freya became the new Principal of LSB.

Miss Freya holds a Level 4 Certificate and Level 5 Diploma in Dance Education from the RAD's Higher Education programme of the same name. She is also a Silver Swans® Licensee, allowing her to teach RAD approved classes for adults of all ages. Miss Freya gained her own RAD RTS in 2018, having successfully completed the prestigious RTS course and examination.

Miss Freya is an experienced dancer having completed all RAD Graded Ballet Examinations, from Pre-Primary to Grade 8 (Distinction), and Intermediate Foundation, Intermediate and Advanced 1 of the RAD Vocational Graded Syllabi. Miss Freya was promoted to Principal aged just 21, and feels extremely privileged to have been asked to follow in Mrs. Chase's footsteps.

LSB specialises in the RAD ballet method. We offer classes at a Pre-School level, following the RAD's Dance To Your Own Tune programme, and all RAD Graded Syllabi from Pre-Primary in Dance to Grade 8. We also offer classes in the RAD's Vocational Graded Syllabi, from Intermediate Foundation to Advanced 2, including pointe work. LSB gives students the opportunity to sit RAD examinations to officially celebrate and progress their achievements. LSB also has an ever-growing group of adult ballet dancers who attend our Silver Swans® classes weekly. Silver Swans® is an RAD developed programme based on significant research into dance practice for adult and older learners.

Outside RAD related work, LSB gives students the opportunity to take part in a variety of performances each year, where choreography is developed specifically to stretch and challenge our dancers. In recent years, Miss Freya has choreographed a number of original works and LSB has challenged dancers to restage a number of Classical Repertoire pieces, including the 'Dance of The Sugar Plum Fairy' from *The Nutcracker*. We also offer older students the opportunity to study Classical Repertoire weekly for additional strength and technique training.

Students are welcomed to all-inclusive and friendly classes which are held mainly at The Woodmead Halls in Lyme Regis (DT7 3PG). You may wish to dance as a hobby, for exercise or more professionally in the future; whatever your reasons, all ages and abilities are catered for at Lyme School of Ballet.
